VK RX 2300 Flint 75 day

- 6-7' tall plant
- 7.5 x 8.5 long ears
- Mostly yellow color with some brown or maroon
- Yields well for early OP
- More flinty type ears
- Finishes fast

WAPSIE VALLEY 85 day (Our Most Popular)

- Available cert. organic
- 9 1/2' tall, strong, widely adapted plants, 12-18 straight kernel rows.
- 7 1/2-8" well formed ears, mostly rich yellow, waxy color with some maroon ears and a few brown colored ears.
- Outstanding plant health, good stand-ability, medium ear placement
- Superior silage choice, average C.P. (Crude Protein) 11%. Finishes for grain where others wont
- Has done well in dry years, heavy test weight
- Available specific any size flat or round

This tremendous variety that has put O.P. corn back on the map and been traced back to Adoulf Steinbronn from Fairbank, Iowa. Steinbronn stood alone when his peers were all going to hybrids. Victor Kucyk, who gives much of his life to the improvement of O.P.'s then continued the work. Many around the globe are benefiting from this variety

Dublin 86 day

- 10' tall plants
- 8 1/2" large yellow ears
- Big yielder for silage or grain
- Stands well with medium ear placement.
- Available any sized flat or round

Victor Kucyk from Dublin Ontario has done it again with this varietal cross. We are very excited about his new Dublin Variety. It is out-yielding any O.P. we put up against it in Western NY.

MINNESOTA 13 87 day

- Cert. organic
- 8' tall plants 7 1/2 - 8 1/2" long ears
- 14-18 straight kernel rows, medium ear placement
- Stands well, does well planted after sod
- Average C.P. 10.5%
- Narrower stalk and leaves lends itself to top grain yield

Rich Holman from Wisconsin has been successfully selecting the earliest and best yield on this strain. GHSG is offering Rich's new strain certified organically grown.

KRUG 95 day

- 9 1/2' tall, hearty plants, 9" long, girthy' ears of medium placements
- Medium stand-ability
- Much variation and quite diverse
- Dual purpose silage/grain

Krug is an improved strain of Reid, developed by George Krug, of Woodford County in central Illinois. This quiet farmer, combined a Nebraska strain of Reid corn with Iowa Gold Mine to make a high yielding yellow corn.

Silver King 100 day

- Wide creamy white kernels
- Medium depth and thickness
- Cobs are white. Ears slowly taper from butt to tip, with slightly wavy rows.

Also known as Wisconsin No. 7 The leading white-dent variety in the Northern part of the Corn Belt. Originally by A.J. Goddard of Ft. Atkinson, Iowa.

REID-Yellow Dent 100-110 day

- 10' tall, hearty plants, 9" long, girthy' ears of medium placement
- 14-18 tight kernel rows, medium stand-ability
- Great dual purpose silage/grain
- Plant at conservative plant population

In the mid 1800's, Robert Reid accidently crossed an old deny variety, "Gordon Hopkins" with an early Native American flint, Little Yellow". This "mistake" is the base of some of the most widely used genetics in corn production today.

Bloody Butcher 110 day

Full season dent, large red ears. A decorative and a useful OP*. True corn flavor.*

GREEN FIELD 114 114 day

- 8-10' tall plants
- Bright, yellow, long, narrow, 14 kernel row ears
- Quite uniform ear placement
- High percentage of double ear plants

Open pollinated corn icon Ned Place's signature variety, Green Field was the name of Ned's farm in OH. Ned had developed this out of Reid yellow dent. Reported yields 190 bu/a in the boot heal area of MO

LANCASTER SURE CROP 120 day

- Towering 10-12' tall plants
- Long 10-12" narrow yellow ears
- High ear Placement
- The combination of big long ears placed high in the air causes stand-ability to be lower than our other varieties

- Primarily used as a silo corn and simple pleasure. Fun to show off these high stalks!

Originated in Lancaster, PA around the turn of the century.

Black Jack Popcorn 80 day

- 4 1/2" plants with low ear placement
- Deep dark burgundy but pops white
- 4-6" almost black ears
- Persistent
- Delicious flavor

Garret Emo has increased this persistent variety of pop corn. Garret received the original genetics from Tim Latsch of Tigerton, WI

Red Clover Medium

Great for hay, green manure or wildlife plots. Fixes nitrogen, regrows vigorously. Planting rates

Alone: 10-20 pounds per acre

In a mix 3-6 pounds per acre

Timothy Seed Climax

A perennial cool-season grass, tall, fine-stemmed and leafy, Climax timothy has been the standard for hay for years.

Planting Rate: Alone: 8-10 pounds per acre

In a mix: 2-6 pounds per acre

Golden Bantam Improved 12 row (sweet corn)

80 day to roasting

- 7' tall plants 8" long ears with 12 kernel rows
- Improved to stay tender longer, have longer ears and more evenly spaced broad kernels.
- Still pick promptly when ready, eat promptly after picking. Delicious!

Everet B. Clark of Milford, CT selected for the 12 kernel rows from the original 8 row W. Atlee Burpees' Golden Bantam.

Golden Batam original 8 row (sweet corn)

76 day to roasting

- 6' tall plants 7" long ears with 8 kernel rows
- Great old-fashioned corn flavor Sweet for an OP
- Pick promptly when ready, eat promptly after picking. Delicious!

Introduced to the corn market by W. Atlee Burpee in 1902 Golden Bantam Corn has a fantastic flavor that is great for home freezing or eating fresh.

JAPANESE HULLESS Popcorn 100 day

- Offered Conventional 100 day
- Non-Hybrid non-GMO Five foot tall plants
- Many times produces multiple ears
- White 4-6" ears. Pops Well.

Much of the standard hybrid micro-wave popcorn has the flavor of the coating that is has been treated with. The Japanese Hulless has an exceptional nutty flavor.

PUMPKIN SEED 99 day Cinderella,

Rouge vif d'Etampes

This Beautiful variety is a French heirloom. Most fruits develop a vivid red hue that is uncommon among any other variety. They're shaped like Cinderella's coach, and seem as if they jumped right out of the fairytale. They come in many sizes, but the average is between 15-20lbs. Their deep orange flesh makes great pies and quick breads once strained and blended. They are also used commonly as a soup tureen.

Revolt 105 Day (cycle 0) Synthetic

A synthetic is a composite of a number of inbred lines that you can save seed from. Work on this synthetic population began in 2003. Its parents were older inbreds that formed strong hybrids and its adaptation is the northern part of the Corn Belt. Has Ga1s trait.

Rebellion 110 Day (cycle 0) Synthetic

This synthetic population began as some preliminary crosses among commercial and university corn belt dent inbred lines in 2003. This was crossed with the Ga1s carriers from Missouri as part of this project. It is likely adapted to the central Corn Belt.

Ga1s are naturally occurring traits in corn that will greatly reduce outcrossing with plants that don't carry the same trait. This trait is called gametophytic incompatibility. This trait helps prevent accepting unwanted pollen from transgenic and other field corn. This is how much of the popcorn stays pure. Revolt and Rebellion are varieties with the Ga1s trait. They were developed by Dr Frank Kutka and the Seed We Need Project with support from by a grant from the Organic Farming Research Foundation. We appreciate Frank's fascinating work.
